- Figures in red are estimates based on the provisional returns from the 2001 Census raw data, which have subsequently been suppressed on the ONS Neighbourhood Census data web-site facility. With the exception of Clatworthy, no known additions to the dwelling stock have been recorded in the intervening decade and, therefore, it has been assumed that the population figures for 2011 are the same as in 2001.
