Subject: PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO THE WEST SOMERSET LOCAL PLAN TO 2032

Dear Sir/Madam,

I write concerning the proposed modifications to the West Somerset local Plan 2032 in particular the changes proposed for early release of **WAT9** (Liddymore Farm).

My principal concerns relate to safety matters; the release suggest 100+ dwellings with site access to the top of Liddymore Road. This access would be shared with, or adjacent to, the Knights Templar first school access road. This is currently a very congested area at school start and finish times and the introduction of a further 100+ cars would have a negative effect on the safety of school children which in turn could result in even more parents deciding to deliver their children to school in cars, a viscous circle. In addition to this Liddymore Road, with the high level of on-road parking, is currently difficult to traverse and this would be worse with the proposed development. Furthermore should the development of WAT9 link Liddymore Road to Liddymore Lane (possible with the schematic presented) the traffic using this route would increase exponentially with a corresponding reduction in safety.

I would request that these concerns are included in any decision making process relating to the early release of WAT9.
