Date flexible use starts: This is for a single continuous period of up to two years from this date. If you wish to change to another use within the two year period you must submit a new notification.

The changes relates to less than 150 sq m in the building, hasn't relied on permission granted by Class D, is not part of a safety hazard area and is not a Listed Building.
